- Norms: The ACT was validated in 2019 with a normative sample of 488 adults in various types of positions (administrative, trades, technical, professional and managerial).
- Reliability: The internal consistency of the overall score (based on Cronbach's alpha coefficients) is 0.82.
- Validity: Correlation coefficients between TCA results and those of other recognised aptitude tests range from 0.73 to 0.82 (convergent validity).
