QIRP™

The QIRP is a psychometric aptitude test. The QIRP provides a measure of the overall cognitive abilities of the person being assessed, based on their ability to quickly solve mathematical, lexical or spatial problems. Taken together, the responses contribute to the assessment of the general intelligence factor, also known as the "g factor". This automated tool provides a rapid overview of the candidate's learning capacity.

EVALUATED DIMENSIONS

- ▶ General intelligence factor (g factor)

PSYCHOMETRIC QUALITIES

- ▶ Norms : The QIRP was validated in 2012 with a normative sample of 2,304 Quebec adults (1,184 women and 1,120 men) of varying levels of education.
- ▶ Reliability : The internal consistency of the overall score (based on Cronbach's alpha coefficients) is 0.82.
- ▶ Validity : The correlation coefficients between QIRP results and those of other recognised aptitude tests range from 0.77 to 0.84 (convergent validity).

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
