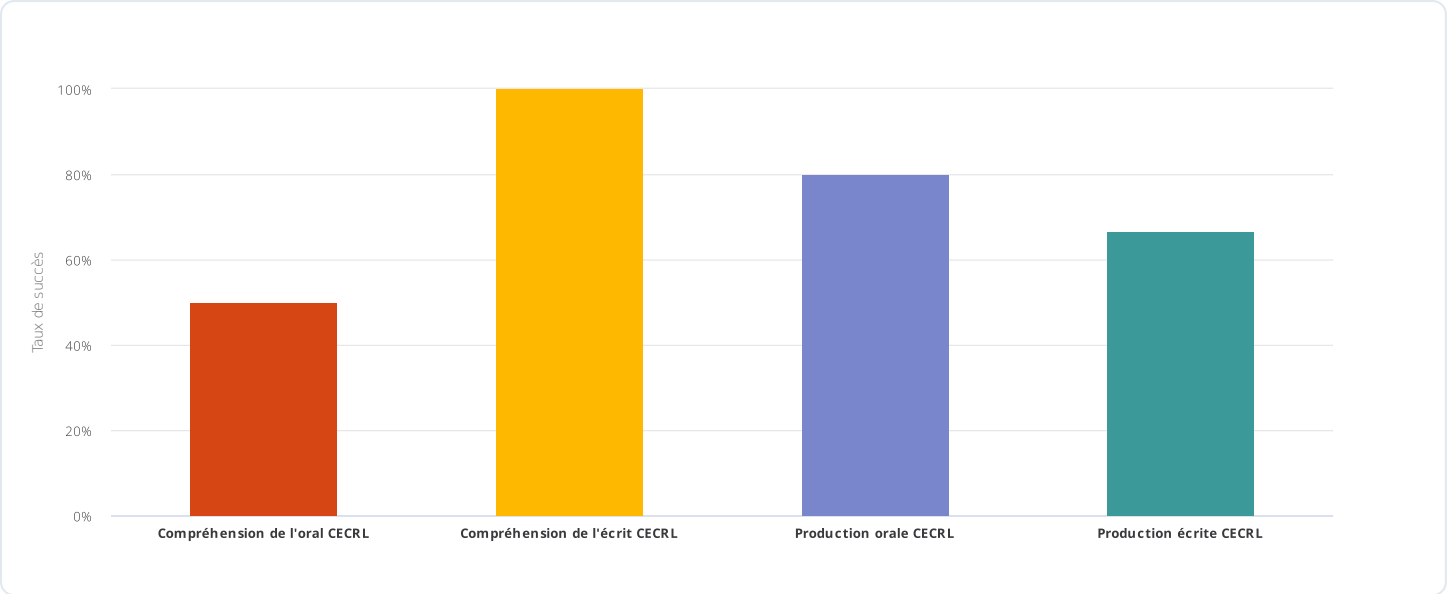

Question

How do you think language shapes our understanding of the world?

Answer with full sentences that includes verbs.

Language is far more than a simple communication tool, it is the lens through which we perceive and interpret reality. The words available to us in our native tongue directly influence how we categorize experience, emotions and concepts. For instance some languages have words for feeling that simply do not exist in others such as the Portuguese *saudade*, a deep nostalgic, Cesaria Evora describes it in one of her famous songs. Without these words, speakers of other languages may struggle to even identify these sensations consciously. Moreover, language shapes our spatial reasoning our perception of time, and even our memory. Research has shown that bilingual individuals may think and behave differently depending on which language they are using, suggesting that switching language is almost like switching worldviews. To conclude, language does not merely describe the world, it constructs it, filtering our experiences through a cultural and linguistic framework that is largely invisible to us.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates strong C2-level vocabulary and sophisticated argumentation with relevant examples. However, multiple spelling and grammar errors undermine the overall quality. The response is well-structured and directly addresses the question with nuanced analysis, but these technical mistakes prevent a higher score at this advanced level.

Question : 2 (ENLE00613)

Question

Write about a memorable trip you took. What did you do there?

My best memory of travelling was during my academic year in Sweden. This experience enabled me to visit numerous countries in Northern Europe and to discover a new culture, a totally different weather and a different lifestyle. I traveled to Lapland to see the breathtaking Northern light, I met people with a different mindset than mine, people I could never have met in other circumstances and I try new dishes sometimes for the best and sometimes for the worst. It was just one year but I grew so much from it.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates good B1 level competence with relevant content and mostly correct grammar. However, spelling errors and some grammatical issues prevent a higher score. The candidate effectively describes their memorable trip with appropriate vocabulary and structure, though minor corrections would strengthen the response.

Question

Describe your ideal holiday. Where would you go and what would you do?

Answer with full sentences that includes verbs.

My ideal holiday is a perfect mix between resting day and active day. So one day I can relax on a beach for hours and the next day go hiking for several hours. It is also very important to me to discover the culture of the country I'm visiting thus I enjoy visiting museum, discovering new dishes that I've never heard of and buy gifts for my friends and family. I want a moderate climate with sun and blue sky without an excessive warmth.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates solid B1 level competency with good vocabulary and sentence structure. The candidate effectively describes their ideal holiday with relevant details and uses varied verbs appropriately. Minor grammatical issues and one spelling error prevent a higher score, but overall communication is clear and well-organized.



Multi-Lingual Advantages: The Benefits of Speaking Three or More Languages

Question

Based on the text, answer to each question in the dedicated area:

1. What are some of the challenges and opportunities associated with the changing nature of work in a globalized economy?

The main challenges is the need for constant adaptability, as workers need to learn new skills to stay competitive. However, globalization also creates opportunities by opening access to talent and jobs from around the world.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates good understanding of the text and addresses key challenges mentioned. However, there are spelling and grammar errors that impact clarity. The response is mostly well-structured but contains mistakes that would be noticeable at B2 level, where accuracy is expected.

2. How can workers prepare for the future of work in a globalized economy?

Workers can prepare by developing both STEM skills and soft skills such as communication and teamwork. They must also develop flexibility and lifelong learning to adapt to a rapidly changing world.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates strong comprehension and relevant content for B2 level. It accurately identifies key points from the text (STEM skills, soft skills, flexibility, and lifelong learning). However, there is one spelling error ('developping') and the response could be slightly more detailed or structured. Overall, it shows good command of English with minor issues.



Multi-Lingual Advantages: The Benefits of Speaking Three or More Languages

Question

Based on the text, answer to each question in the dedicated area:

1. Why are multilingual employees in demand?

Nowadays being multilingual is a real asset in the job market because multilingual employee can deal efficiently with international customer, open a subsidiary in a new country or handle multiculturalism.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates good understanding of the topic and relevant content from the reference document. However, there are spelling and grammar errors that affect clarity. The response is mostly well-structured but contains mistakes that would be expected to be avoided at B2 level.

2. What are the personal benefits of speaking several languages?

According to the author, multilingual people are more open-minded because they know different cultures and also it enables them to have a more diverse social circle.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates good comprehension of the reference material and addresses the question adequately. However, there is one spelling error ('differents' instead of 'different') and one grammar mistake ('differents cultures' should be 'different cultures'). The response is well-structured and relevant, making it suitable for B2 level with minor corrections needed.



The Impact of Climate Change on Society

Question

Based on the text, answer to each question in the dedicated area:

1. What are some of the benefits and challenges of the rise of AI?

AI brings many benefits such as automating task, increasing efficiency and creating new opportunities for innovation. However, it also raises serious concerns about job displacement, privacy and ethical problems.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates solid B2 level competence with clear, well-structured expression and accurate use of complex sentences. The response directly addresses the question with relevant information from the document. Minor grammatical imprecision slightly impacts the score, but overall comprehension and communication are strong.

2. What are the potential long-term impacts of AI on society?

In the long-term AI could transform society by developing life-changing new technologies. However it is important to develop reponsible ethical guidelines to ensure its safe use.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates good B2-level comprehension and expression. It accurately captures key points from the text about AI's transformative potential and ethical concerns. However, there is one spelling error ('reponsible' instead of 'responsible') that slightly detracts from the overall quality. The response is well-structured and coherent.



The Impact of Climate Change on Society

Question

Based on the text, answer to each question in the dedicated area:

1. What are some of the physical and social effects of climate change?

Climate change highlights inequalities between developed countries and developing countries, indeed in developing countries they don't have the same infrastructures to deal with climate change's effect on nature such as the rising of sea level or extreme weather.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates good understanding of the reference material and addresses the question relevantly. However, there are spelling errors ('inequalities', 'developped', 'developping') and minor grammar issues that affect clarity. For B2 level, these mistakes are notable but the overall communication remains effective.

2. How is climate change impacting different regions of the world?

Climate change is handled differently in developed countries versus developing countries, because developing countries are less prepared and are more vulnerable.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates good understanding of the reference material and addresses the key distinction between developed and developing countries. However, spelling errors and a minor grammatical issue prevent a higher score. For B2 level, accuracy in written English is important.

Question

Listen to the recording and answer to each question with complete sentences in the dedicated area.

Answer with a full sentence that includes a verb.

1. What is the name of the sculpture we are discussing?

The name is The Venus of Milo.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer is grammatically correct and contains no spelling mistakes. It directly addresses what the sculpture is called. However, for B2 level, the response is quite minimal and lacks elaboration. A more comprehensive answer incorporating additional details from the audio would better demonstrate B2 proficiency.

2. What goddess does the sculpture depict?

It is the Greek goddess of love : Aphrodite.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer is relevant and contains a complete sentence with a verb as required. However, there is one spelling mistake ('godess' instead of 'goddess'). The grammar is generally correct, though the structure could be more sophisticated for B2 level. Overall, the response adequately addresses the question despite minor errors.

3. What material is the sculpture made from?

The sculpture is made from marble.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer is grammatically correct, well-spelled, and directly addresses the audio content. It meets the B2 requirement of using a complete sentence with a verb. The response is concise and accurate, though it could have included more detail about the marble quality mentioned in the audio.

Question

Listen to the recording and answer to each question with complete sentences in the dedicated area.

Answer with a full sentence that includes a verb.

1. What is the recommended first step in preparing the water for brewing tea ?

You need high quality tea leaf

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer contains a grammar error (missing article 'a' before 'high quality') and lacks the required verb-focused complete sentence structure specified in the instructions. While it addresses relevant content from the audio, it falls short of B2 expectations for sentence complexity and grammatical accuracy.

2. What is the key to creating a delightful cup of tea?

You need to enjoy each sip slowly

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates good command of English with correct grammar and spelling. It contains a complete sentence with a verb as required. However, the answer is somewhat incomplete as it only addresses one aspect of tea brewing mentioned in the audio, missing other important steps like selecting quality leaves, using filtered water, and measuring tea leaves.

Listen to the recording and answer to each question with complete sentences in the dedicated area.

Answer with a full sentence that includes a verb.

1. Which buildings are located in Trafalgar Square?

There is the British museum

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer is severely deficient. It contains a grammar error ('There is' should be 'There is a'), lacks proper sentence structure, and most critically, is completely irrelevant to the audio content. The candidate was asked to answer a question about the recording but provided no actual question to answer, and the British Museum was never mentioned in the audio.

2. Where is Covent Garden located?

Covent Garden is in the city center

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer is grammatically correct, well-spelled, and directly addresses the audio content. It forms a complete sentence with a verb as required. The response demonstrates solid B1 level English proficiency with clear, accurate expression.

Answer with a full sentence that includes a verb.

1. Where did the speaker and his friends go last weekend?

They did a camping trip in a beautiful forest

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates solid A2-level competency with correct grammar and spelling. It includes a complete sentence with a verb as required. However, it lacks some detail from the audio content (campfire, marshmallows, hiking, stories) and could be more comprehensive for a higher score.

2. What activity did they do the next day?

The next day they went hiking

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates good comprehension of the audio content and meets the A2 level requirements. It contains a complete sentence with a verb as instructed. The grammar and spelling are correct. However, the answer could be slightly more detailed to fully showcase language proficiency at this level.

Question : 12 (ENLE00745)

And in conclusion, a healthy work-life balance is not a luxury.

Justification de l'évaluation : The candidate demonstrates B2-level competence with clear structure and relevant content. However, several grammar errors and awkward phrasings prevent a higher score. The answer addresses both parts of the question adequately but lacks sophistication in expression expected at B2 level.

Question : 13 (ENLE00739)

Discuss the impact of social media on personal relationships. How has it changed the way people communicate?

Social media has profoundly changed the way people communicate and maintain personal relationships. On one hand, it has made staying connected easier than ever. We can instantly reach friends and family across the world, share moments in real time, and maintain relationships that distant would have otherwise ended. However, social media has also a darker side. Face-to-face interactions are decreasing, as people often prefer texting over meeting in person. This can lead to more superficial relationships, where the quality of connection is sacrificed. Moreover, constant exposure to other highlights reels can create feelings of jealousy, loneliness, and low self-esteem. To conclude, while social media is a powerful communication tool, it is important to use it meaningfully and never let it replace meaningful human connection.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates strong B2-level competence with well-structured arguments, appropriate vocabulary, and mostly accurate grammar. The response directly addresses the question with balanced perspectives on social media's impact. Minor grammatical errors prevent a higher score, but overall communication is clear and effective.

Question : 14 (ENLE00721)**0.7/1****Question**

What has been your most exciting traveling experience so far? Why?

My most exciting traveling experience was during my academic year in Sweden. I spent one year there. This experience enabled me to visit numerous countries in Northern Europe and to discover a new culture that is totally different from my French culture and also a totally different climate because there was snow from May to August. And also to discover a different lifestyle where every Swedish people talk in English and also I saw a lot of daddy with children outside. And I traveled to Lapland to see the breathtaking Northern Lights. I met people with different mindsets than mine, people I could never have met in other circumstances. And finally I also tried new dishes, sometimes for the better, sometimes for the worst. But it was just one year but I grew so much from it and it enables me to get out of my comfort zone.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates good fluency and covers the question well with specific examples. However, several grammar errors and awkward phrasings prevent it from reaching C1 level. The candidate shows ability to explain motivations and reflect on experiences, but needs more precision in expression.

Question : 15 (ENLE00737)**1/1****Question**

Speak about a time when you faced a significant challenge at work. How did you handle it, and what was the outcome?

Votre enregistrement doit durer au minimum 50 secondes.

My significant challenge at work was when I was a customer success in a French software company, and I was dealing with a big client with a very challenging project. We had two months to implement four software in four subsidiaries in different countries. So the challenge was huge, and we have some problem with dealing with local administrators. But I figured it out, and the solution was to organize different meetings with each local administrator to really understand their needs, and to give them a personal and custom training about the software, and to really understand what they want. And at the end of the day, the project was a success.

Justification de l'évaluation : The candidate demonstrates B2-level competence with generally clear communication and appropriate vocabulary. However, several grammar errors and minor structural issues prevent a higher score. The answer is well-organized and addresses the question comprehensively, showing good problem-solving skills and reflection.

Question : 16 (ENLE00736)**1/1****Question**

In many countries, the number of people choosing to live alone is increasing. Discuss the reasons behind this trend and its potential consequences.

Votre enregistrement doit durer au minimum 50 secondes.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer demonstrates B2-level competence with generally clear expression and relevant content. However, it lacks depth in analysis and contains some grammatical issues. The response addresses both reasons and consequences but remains somewhat superficial and personal rather than analytical.
